- A medalist (top 8) in a national USFA event (Junior Olympics, NAC, Summer Nationals)
- A medalist (top 8) in a USFA Super Youth Circuit (SYC) event
- Ranking on the USFA National Rolling Points Standings (NRPS)

3. Use only the space provided. Applicants will be selected solely on the information contained in this form, the attachment and the recommendations.
